Seasonal Flu Vaccinations

Patients who are 65 or older on 31st March 2019 are eligible for vaccination, along with any patient under 65 who has any of the following: Chronic Lung Disease, Diabetes, Heart problems,

Liver or Kidney Disease, Lowered Immunity, Neurological Disease or is Pregnant.

Shingles Vaccination Programme

You are eligible for this routine vaccination programme when you become **70** years old. The catch up programme is for those aged **78 & 79** years old.

The effectiveness of the vaccine declines with age and so is not recommended for people aged 80 years or older.

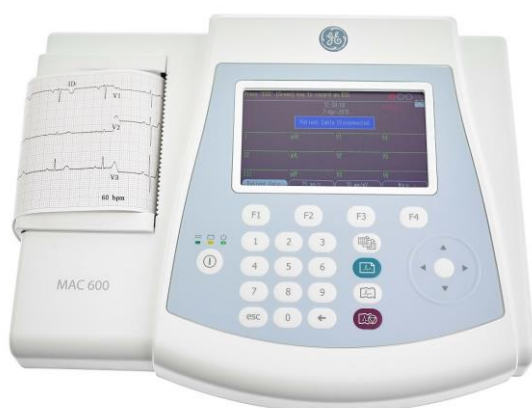
